Free Activity for Jubilee Fun

Castles & Flags: An outdoor activity for the Jubilee and Summer Holidays

Have fun with your child making sand or mud castles and your own flags. If you're lucky enough to be near a sandy beach or have a sandpit in the garden, great! If not, you can buy a small amount of play sand and put it in a plant tray or similar, or mud from the garden. Gather up buckets and spades, or a variety of plastic containers to make different shaped castles, such as plastic cups and bowls, cut down water bottles (careful of sharp edges). For the flags, you will need short sticks and pieces of paper cut to size and shape, paints/felt pens and some glue or sticky tape.

Little ones will have fun filling and emptying the buckets and containers, and finger painting their flags.

Older ones will enjoy designing their own flags and castles with your help. Let them bring in some of their miniature toys to create a miniworld – cars, toy people etc. You could even create a Mini Jubilee Pageant with a moated



castle and little boats!
